Who can run for the board?

Any resident (homeowner or renter), business owner, representative of an institution (school or nonprofit) in the Audubon neighborhood is eligible to run for a seat on the board.

What do board members do?

All ANA board members must:

- Make a two-year commitment
- Attend all board meetings

- Attend board orientation
- Serve on at least one committee

Other roles and responsibilities:

- Reach out to engage community members on a regular basis
- Share information you learn with those around you
- Be informed and prepared by reading your board information packet before meetings
- Financial oversight through monthly finance reports and yearly budgets
- Time commitment is approximately 5-7 hours per month.
